Greetings from Ancient Ways!

We hope this annual letter finds all of you, your family and friends, safe and well. As a steady rain continues to pour down outside, and daytime now seems to zip by, I'm starting to realize we are finally heading into winter here and, at least for us, we have a little more time for some of those indoor projects. It also gives us time to reflect and learn from a variety of unexpected things that happened to Ancient Ways and Nhimbe over the past year. And I do mean variety. I remember our optimism at the beginning of this year, while finalizing our plans and budget for Nhimbe, only to see them gradually get disrupted and deteriorate as the year went on. Yet, as this letter lays out, we plowed through and not only prevailed but showed once again how capable the Nhimbe organization is at responding and adjusting to severe adversities.

Over this past year Nhimbe dealt with the continuous effects of the Covid-19 pandemic, which resulted in the periodic school lockdowns and additional expenditures for government-mandated Covid protection supplies. The Nhimbe facilities also suffered damages caused by a cyclone and a wild fire. Additionally, residents are currently facing a food shortage due to the cyclone and other inclement weather. At every step of the way we were able to adjust and cope with these unforeseen events largely because of the incredible generosity we received from you our donors, and the dedication of our Zimbabwean colleagues in Mhondoro working together with Jaiaen. The new team that we have in place in Zimbabwe was fully tested this year, and met these challenges head-on by demonstrating their leadership capabilities, resilience and flexibility in the face of several unforeseen hardships. We are very fortunate to have this partnership in place.

In the coming year we will continue our focus on providing support for the Nhimbe preschool, the Mhandara Monthly Care MMC (including sewing, monthly supplies and marimba lessons), our new expanding library, along with funding for additional Wells (new or repairs) as well as Covid-19 support with soap and training. Ancient Ways has been very fortunate to receive a diversity of assistance from many individuals, organizations and government agencies over the last 22 years on behalf of Nhimbe.
